

COOKING WITH PROPANE

Awesome Sausage, Apple and Cranberry Stuffing

Ingredients:

- 1 ½ cups cubed whole wheat bread
- 3 ¾ cups cubed white bread
- 1 pound ground turkey sausage
- 1 cup chopped onion
- ¾ cup chopped celery
- 2 ½ teaspoons dried sage
- 1 ½ teaspoons dried rosemary
- ½ teaspoon dried thyme
- 1 Golden Delicious apple, cored and chopped
- ¾ cup dried cranberries
- ½ cup minced fresh parsley
- 1 cooked turkey liver, finely chopped
- ¾ cup turkey stock
- 4 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted

Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degree F (175 degree C). Spread the white and whole wheat bread cubes in a single layer on a large baking sheet. Bake for 5 to 7 minutes in the preheated oven, or until evenly toasted. Transfer toasted bread cubes to a large bowl.
2. In a large skillet, cook the sausage and onions over medium heat, stirring and breaking up the lumps until evenly browned. Add the celery, sage, rosemary, and thyme; cook, stirring, for 2 minutes to blend flavors.
3. Pour sausage mixture over bread in bowl. Mix in chopped apples, dried cranberries, parsley, and liver. Drizzle with turkey stock and melted butter, and mix lightly. Spoon into turkey to loosely fill.

Litter Quality Propane offers many innovative programs to meet the needs and expectations of our customers. These programs go beyond the normal fixed and market rates offered in the propane industry. The Range, Pick A Price, Vapor Management and Bullseye Prebuy programs are available because our customers asked for them.



The Range Program is great for customers who like the security that fixed pricing offers, but also want to take advantage of lower pricing should the propane market make it available. Here's how it works: We lock in an annual, per gallon, price range for you. There's a "not to exceed" price and a "could go as low as" price. During the year, the propane price will move through the range as the market changes, never exceeding the highest price in the range and possibly going down to the lowest. What makes the range program great is that it offers both security and flexibility all in one program. You're protected against upward surges in price if the propane market gains strength and you also get the benefit of paying less for your propane if the market becomes weak and prices fall. So as we like to say, "You win if the market goes up or down".



The Pick A Price program allows you to do just that - pick your price for the propane that is delivered to your home. You can pick from several paired prices. Once you choose your per gallon price, you pay a monthly guarantee adjustment fee to ensure the price you picked stays fixed.



Tired of paying those big delivery bills? Now you can pay for what you consume. "There's no bill when there's a fill!" with the Vapor Management Program.

Using the latest technology in the propane industry, your propane consumption is monitored remotely and you pay for what you use on a monthly basis.



The convenience offered by the Vapor Management Program is unsurpassed. If you leave your home for a period of time during the heating season, you can let us know and we'll monitor your inside home temperature. If we see your home's temperature has dropped significantly, we'll contact you. You can then make the necessary arrangements to avoid costly repairs. The Vapor Management Program is available only from LQP.

Now you have the opportunity to prepay for your propane. The Bullseye Prebuy program gives our customers an opportunity to purchase a portion of their future propane requirements for the upcoming heating season.
